Hello,

At first, unzip mod_ariprocesscontent.zip and choose appropriate version of plugin (mod_ariprocesscontent.1.5.zip for Joomla 1.5 or mod_ariprocesscontent.1.0.zip for Joomla 1.0). After this login to backend part of your joomla site. If you use Joomla 1.5 then go to Extension->Install/Uninstall and specify location of mod_ariprocesscontent.1.5.zip in 'Upload Package File' section and click 'Install' button. After this active plugin. That's all :)

ARI Process Content is a system module. It just adds the ability to process content with plugins/mambots on selected pages. It does not have user interfase on front-end of Joomla!. So you will not see it in any position.

To use the plugin you should install it via standard Joomla! installer (please be sure that you have appropriate permissions for folders like "modules"), activate it and assign it to appropriate pages. You will not need to include the module somewhere. Once it is enabled it allow the content on assigned pages to be processed by plugins/mambots.
