You can read about licenses in our F.A.Q. section 4. About source code, the component isn't under GNU GPL license, it's under ARI Soft license and core files are obfuscated. You can find plugins for the component under GPL license in plugins repository. The component installs plugins to /plugins/content/arismartcontent/ folder for Joomla! 1.5 and to /mambots/content/arismartcontent/ for Joomla! 1.0, this folder contains sub-folder for each plugin where you can find CSS files. You can use CSS template (CSS Templates section on the component backend) for overriding CSS rules.
