You can wrap "ARI CSV Table" plugin with "ARI JDataTable" plugin. The code will look like:

Using "Default jQuery UI 1.7.2 theme" drop-down in "ARI JQuery UI Loader" plugin settings to choose a theme for "ARI JDataTable".

Hi,
I tried that before and it did nothing at all? I also noticed that the plug-in ARI JQuery UI Loader seems to be grayed out, so I'm not sure if its enabled or not. It is not giving me an option to enable it either. When I hover over the enable tick box I just get a 'no entry' mouse symbol and can't click on it.
Although I can select themes on the right hand side fine. But once again there is no visual output.

I have changed the code the way you suggested, by wrapping it. The output was the same as it was in the screenshot I attached in the first post. Literally nothing changed visually.
Unfortunately I'm working on localhost so I don't have a live website to show you. (I should probably mention that I'm working in Joomla 3)

If you see a blank page, it means a PHP error occurs. For example it can occur if value of "memory_limit" PHP parameter is exhausted. Error message can be found in web server error log. Usually it is available in hosting panel or you can set "Error Reporting" parameter to "Development" in Joomla! settings.

PS: You can try to increase value of "memory_limit" PHP parameter with help of PHP Settings plugin.

It was then suggested I try to set "All components" parameter to "Yes" in "System - ARI Smart Content" Joomla! plugin and set "Needs jQuery load" parameter to "No" in "ARI JQuery Loader" plugin settings.

That didn't change anything either.

Any more suggestions as to why its not displaying properly?

Add the following code to {aricsvtable}:

```

You can also add an unique CSS class name for the table. For this use "className" attribute for {aricsvtable} tag. For example className="myTable" and then use the following CSS rule:

TABLE.myTable .actRow_0 {
  font-size: 15px;
  font-weight: bold;
  background-color: #19265E;
  color: #fff;
}
```

PS: "ARI JDataTable" doesn't work with HTML tables which use "colspan" or "rowspan".
