Now, it overrides the vertical menu width.

Hello,

We have updated the module. Now it contains new parameter 'CSS Styles' which helps override menu styles or add new styles. You can use { \$id } predefined variable which will be replaced with id of menu container. In you case, you can download updated version, upgdate it on your site and place the following CSS rule in 'CSS Styles' parameter:

#{ $id } ul li.yuimenubaritem {  
width: 83px; /* 163px or 173px */  
}
```
