I have a 35 question quiz, each question worth 1 point. Users need to get $27 / 35(77 \%)$ to pass. The math is being done correctly in terms of the calculating the correct score for the user, however, some users have "passed" with as low as 17/35 (48\%) correct.

Other than the handful of users who have been told they passed when they did not, the quiz seems to work OK. The quiz is a combination of yes/no, true/false, choose one, and choose multiple. There doesn't seem to be anything wrong with the questions themselves that I can see.

Where do I need to look to find out why the component is "passing" failed quizes?
