I am evalutating your AriQuiz light and I am wondering if it's possible to create for each quiz list name, many subcategories.

The component seems to allow to set even endless quiz categories but just only under 1 main category. For example in "Quiz List" I have Name=x Category=y. I would like to have under the Name=x, other 10 guiz categories per each name.

Something like Category VEHICLE - Quiz Name:CARS - Subcategory Quiz1 Name=FERRARI - Subcategory Quiz 2 Name=PORSCHE - Subcategory Quiz3 Name=LAMBORGHINI etc... Then Quiz Name:MOTORBIKES Subcategory Quiz1 Name=HONDA - Subcategory Quiz 2 Name=DUCATI - Subcategory Quiz3 Name=SUZUKY etc...

Basically what I need is to have a step more for creating another category.
