now I have another question, as you go to this website [mvcaog.org](http://mvcaog.org) , you can see that I am trying to make the

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background and the banner change at the same time, it has been working great (by pretty much using all the same settings on both module, especially all the timing)

however, when I start clicking on the left or right, every now and then, I see that the banner and the background start to off sync. It is natural, because they are actually separate element

after playing with them for a while, I start to notice something, whenever I press the left (or right) button, the timer on the banner reset (i.e., let say it takes 6 sec for banner to auto switch; but each time after I change it manually, the timer will start from 0 to count), but the background banner doesn't reset, which is causing them to off sync

is there any way I can make the back slider to do the same as the front, i.e. the timer reset?
