I put it on my website, the link text is just as big as it should be (and like it is, when the option "module" is selected in Xampp). In other words: I can't provide you that link, but I can tell you there is a difference between the way the link text is shown for modules and for inline content. Option "modules" works without any problems, even in Xampp.
