I'm having the same problem and tried the solution suggested, but it doesn't seem to be working for me. I'm not an expert on CSS and I might not be placing the rule in the right context.

I'm using the beez 20 template and added the rule to the template.css and template rtl.css files. I copied and pasted just as shown, pasted only the items in braces as their own section, and pasted just the rule within the "body" tag. None of them worked. I'm certain I'm putting it in the wrong context.
