In the link url of the picture i've placed:

index.php?option=com_content&view=article&id=2&tmpl=component&TB_iframe=1&width=800&height=600.

I expected that would start the article in the lightbox.

When that didnt work, i have added the code :{arisexylightbox activeType="article" width="300" height="300" id="3" title="Article" }{/arisexylightbox}

in article 2, and hoped that that will start the lightbox with the text of article 3.

But nothing happened.
