Currently the pop up can be viewed here. The module position is set to "offcanvas". An alternate pop up can be viewed here. On this page, the module position is set to "top-a"... you should see a blank module to the right of the social icons. This site uses the Warp framework from YooTheme, however even if I set the module to hide on mobile (tablet or phone) in the template settings, the module remains published.
