Hi Sorry i could not find a thread for Ari Sexy Thumbnail so guess maybe this is the right place

We are using Ari Sexy Thumbnail to get the click function on a picture to enlarge it. ITs working very well

However we also use Droppics with its build in system for enlarge picture, however this has stopped working after installing Ari Sexy Thumbnail

I contacted droppics support to see if there was a way to igonre the ari code for their slideshow? Here is their answer:
Hi,

In fact it's not Droppics which need to ignore ARI plugins but ARI needs to ignore Droppics.

I can't do anything as ARI plugins search for all images in the page through a plugin system an replace our content.

You should better ask to ARI's developers how to disable the plugin for some sources folders.
I have tried to find a parameter like that in the ARI plugin configuration but I can't find it.

It is possible to use the extension only for images with specific CSS class. Use "Specific CSS classes" parameter in plugin settings for this purpose.

Is that right?

It's a shame as you guys have some great products and i have purchased several of them over some time for my customers.

We have updated the extension. "ARI Sexy Thumbnails" plugin v. 1.11.4 contains "Ignore folders" and "Ignore sub-folders" parameters. They can be used to ignore images from the selected folders. For example if want to ignore images from /images/avatars folder, set "Ignore folders" parameter to images/avatars value.

The latest version of the extension is available in "Member Area". Update "ARI Sexy Lightbox" module and "ARI Sexy Thumbnails" plugin.

I can see that the droppics system still does not work
If i look at the source code of the article that contain the droppics code it looks like this:

Teacher Training Colleges introduction text

This despite the physical files is stored in /images/com_droppics/123 (1 number pr album)

I guess the reason why its not working is because the code above actually does not even look in the /image folder

Is there a solution to this you think?

If not its not a very big problem as I can use Widgikit instead of Droppics with more or less the same result.

I am really happy for what you have done as it makes it possible for me to continue to use this fantastic plugin
