If you want to use the module, set "Choose type" parameter to "Image gallery", enter path to folder(s) with images in "Image gallery -> Directories" parameter, set "Image gallery -> Layout type" to "Custom text", enter the next code in "Layout type -> Custom type -> Template" parameter:

Where LINK TO THUMBNAIL is link to a thumbnail.

Set "Padding" and "Margin" parameters to 0 that avoid white border. Set "Title position" parameter to "Outside" that show titles as on provided screenshot.

I set the "Mode" parameter to "Anywhere" in "System - ARI Fancybox Anywhere" plugin settings. but I may have changed other settings which have messed things up. Could you help me with other settings in that plugin?

The other thing is, with my module settings, everything is great for the original fancybox but when the window pops up, it doesn't start the slideshow of images. I have to manually click through them. Could you tell me where I turn this on? I can't seem to find where that is.

I forgot, also when I do use the anywhere plugin setting and add the {arifancybox activeType="imglist" dir="PATH_TO_IMAGE_FOLDER" thumbWidth="125" type="customtext"}{/arifancybox} syntax in to my custom html module, I can't work out how to get the slideshow starting on the image I want (which is different to the image I want the other thumbnail to start on - but both will be from the same images folder). I tried adding a second csv file and changing the order but it still starts with image 001.jpg regardless of how I seem to set it.

I noticed in the System - ARI Fancybox Anywhere that there isn't an option to set it to "customtext" and I'm wondering if this is the problem or if it is something else I have set incorrectly in that interface. Does the syntax I put in the page override the settings in the plugin or do I have to get it right in the plugin and then just add the code you have provided below? Sorry about my lack of understanding of this.

Sorry to keep sending messages before you have had a chance to respond to the last.

I have used the module anywhere functionality to place 2 thumbnails inside another joomla module. I used {arifancybox moduleId="91"} and this works. I have 2 ari fancybox windows opening from the thumbs I have set up. My problem is, when I add the ARI fancybox module of my other slideshow (the one on the right hand side of the screen), the small thumbnails on the left side don't launch the slideshows any more. They still have a changed cursor on rollover but clicking doesn't do anything.

The right hand module does overlap the module that my 2 thumbs are in so I'm wondering if it is a layer/z-index thing. Do you know if there is any reason why an ARI fancybox module and a module anywhere instance can't work on the same page?
