I have a form built in RSForm Pro which I'm currently popping up in a Rokbox window but I'd prefer to have it pop up in ARI Fancybox which I am using for all the other popups on my site. I was wondering if I am able to launch the fancybox window with the form in it from an image link and secondly if I would be able to auto close the popup window when I clicked the submit button on the form?

So link from an image to launch fancybox containing a form which I can then close the fancybox window on submit.

Could you tell me whether this might be possible and could you suggest how I might do this?

Try now please.

If you want to close the lightbox when a user clicks submit button, we can offer the next solution:

1. Create an article with the next javascript code:

```
if (self != window.top && typeof(window.parent.jQuery) != "undefined")
{
    var $ = window.parent.jQueryFB || window.parent.jQuery;
    if (typeof($.fn.fancybox) != "undefined")
        $.fn.fancybox.close();
}
```

}

2. Use link to created article as redirect url for the form.

PS: We can help to configure the form, if you grant super-administrator permissions because we can't enter javascript code with provided permissions.

If I wanted to modify the lightbox window for a different window, I was wondering if I could use the `opt_scrolling` and `opt_showNavArrows` somehow?

What I need to do is set it so scrollbars don't show up and so the navigation buttons don't show up.

I thought about trying to put it in `class="arifancybox iframe {width: 548, height: 400, scrolling: off, showNavArrows: off}`

but it makes the link load in a new window instead of a lightbox so I'm thinking I have the syntax wrong. :)

Would you have any suggestions on how I would set these options?

Hi

I gave that a shot but unfortunately it didn't work for me. The scrollbars and navigation arrows still show up, at least on a Mac in Safari and Firefox. Should I be updating any of the plugins as well, and if so, could you tell me which one to play with?

Actually I just had a play around with the settings in "System - ARI Fancybox" and my popup is taking its settings from there. That is fine for one window but I'd really love to get the syntax working so that I can set these parameters from the

links like you were showing me. Otherwise I'll only be able to open up one window size across the site. I think you said that these links should override the settings in the plugin so if I can get this to work, that will be perfect. I can then use the plugin settings for the default and override with the links when I need to.

Sorry for the confusion. This window is appearing correctly but that is because I changed the settings in the plugin. It isn't getting these settings from the link which I need it to do so I can open different windows with different sizes and settings on other pages.

If you need access to the backend, you can login as username *** and password ***
I have set you up as a super administrator.

If you look at the module "Timber_Thumb_Afrormosia" ID114 you can see the link syntax that you provided me but it wouldn't change the settings when I used it in the page. The only way they would change was to change them in the plugin parameters of "System - ARI Fancybox".

And also I have another question.

I am displaying videos using this code and in several browsers all is good but in IE 8 and 9 and Chrome, the close button displays in front until the video loads and then displays behind. this is even if the video doesn't come right to the edge of the window. I tried increasing the z-index of the fancybox-close ID in the stylesheet but it had no effect.

Could you help me with this at all?

I looked in fancybox key/value options but couldn't see anything except swf transparency which I set to transparent.

and then click on one of the thumbnails in the page (they have the orange play buttons in the middle of them). They are all the same and are duplicates of the same module and are placed in the page using moduleanywhere.

I disabled your password in the backend because I was a bit nervous once I realised I had posted the password for all the world to see. If you need access again I'll send you a password for the same username. Just let me know the safest way to do that.

Thanks very much for that workaround. I see what you have done which is to move the close button outside the video display area and that does make sure the close button isn't obscured by the video.

I'm sorry to be a pain, but my client is very pedantic about the design which has the button sitting where it was. Is there any way using z-index or anything else that I can force the close button to display in front of the video?

Ok, thanks very much for looking at it for me.

I'm wondering if one last possibility might be to load an iframe into the fancybox and then embed the video in the html page that is loaded there?

I had a quick play with embedding the movie using All Video plugin and using ARI Fancybox to call the article that the video is embedded in.

This did fix the close button problem but I'm having trouble getting the window to open looking like I want it.

I'm wondering if you could look at my syntax for calling the popup and see if I am sabotaging the resulting layout with it. Also, if you were to approach it this way, would you use All Video as the embedding tool or do you have another plugin that you would recommend?

Here is the syntax I am using for the fancybox...

Hi again,

I wanted to ask you a question about this line of code that was commented out to allow the styling to be used on links. When this line is commented out, the Touch base slider (orange tab) at the top right hand side of the page, doesn't work. Do you know what I might be able to do to have them both work? Maybe there is a call in the slider code that calls that version of jquery specifically that I can change to call the version you are using (which I think is much newer)
