Hello,

1. Yes, file name with extension should be placed into the CSV file.

2. Place CSV file into folder with images.

For example if you want to show images from directory /images/gallery/ and add titles for the next images:

image\_01.jpg photo\_01.png

Place CSV file with the next content into /images/gallery/ folder:

"File","Title" "image\_01.jpg","Test image" "photo\_01.png","Another test image"

Try now please. We have found several problems:

1. CSV file name is case-sensitive so Ariimagepopup.csv and ariimagepopup.csv are two different files.

2. CSV file was saved in incorrect format. Header columns "File" and "Title" were missed.

3. Image file names are case-sensitive so Da,\_Brush\_Interdental\_EI2-5p.jpg not the same as DA,\_brush\_interdental\_EL2-5P.jpg
