We have reproduces this issue in Google Chrome. This problem with site template styles. Open /templates/commportal/css/template.css file, find the next CSS rule:

html {  
    margin-bottom: 1px;  
    height: 100%!important;  
    height: auto;  
}
```

and replace it with:

```
html {  
    margin-bottom: 0;  
    height: 100%!important;  
    height: auto;  
}
```
