Component won\'t work

Note that the buttons at the bottom link to an image and to a url, respectively. You can check on your browser and see that both links contain rel="sexylightbox" on the attributes. They are the content of a module. The component is activated, already tried turning jQuery on and off.

If you want to use sexy lightbox in any content (not only in articles), you can be interested in ARI Sexy Lightbox package. It contains "System - ARI Sexy Lightbox" plugin which provides ability to use the lightbox in any content.

Thanks for the quick reply! So if I make a small article space and place the buttons in an article, it'll work?

EDIT: Tested it and now I have a different problem. When I click "cardбpio", the lighbox opens and just loads and loads and never shows the image. I have to close the lighbox and click "cardбpio" again, and then it opens immediately with the image. I already tried pre-loading the image on the article html, but no luck.

The lightbox for the "como chegar" button was also breaking the site. Clicking it would open a lightbox of 0px, with all the corner and loading graphics on top of eachother. Then if I closed it and clicked "cardapio" (which was supposed to show an image), it showed the "como chegar" page!

The article quite simply contains:

(That first line is my attempt at preloading the image. The errors remain with or without it)

I have removed the lightbox calls from the site to avoid messing with current users, but the client still expects me to get it working asap.

EDIT 2: I have activated the calls again at a hidden page. You can see and test at

http://www.mixpotato.com.br/votuporangateste/

Click "CardD±pio". It was supposed to show an image, but it just loads and loads.

Now close it. Click "CardD±pio" again. Image immediately shows.

Now click "Como chegar". It was supposed to show a page within the site.

It shows the image from before, with broken alignments.

Now close it. Click "CardD±pio" again.

Now it doesn't show the image, but shows the page the other button was supposed to! With broken alignments and no background image, to top it off.

Really, really weird behavior. I would really appreciate any further help.

About problem on test site, set "Move duration" and "Resize duration" parameters to "1" instead of "0" value.

Thanks for the reply! I thought it was possible to use 0 values there, since they are time variables. Anyway, removed all 0's from my parameters, and now the images work perfectly (Cardбpio), but the page link still shows the same bug (Como Chegar). It's supposed to open http://www.mixpotato.com.br/mapavotu, but it just shows a very small loading bar inside a 0px window frame.
But at least we're making progress, huh! Hahaha
Also, maybe this isn't related to the problem, but the Cardбpio button often appears distorted and small, even though it has correct sizes set on the article HTML. Reloading the page usually solves the problem, but that's far from desirable. Any ideas?
