Hello,

The component works very nice and we are really happy to use it, but we have one serious issue. We can't appoint different scoring for multiple choice question (sorry if i missed it, but i could not find it). For example, even if people check corectly 5 from 6 correct answers they still get 0 points. People complaint that this is unfair and it really is. The only way is to downgrade the complexity of multiple choice questions, but then multiple coice questions have a little sense as they are becoming similar to single choice questions.

It would be ideal if we could apply such scoring formulas for multiple choice questions:

- * everything or nothing (as it is now);
- * percentage of correct answers;
- * percentage of correct answers - incorrectly checked answers > 0
