At that time there were no question bank feature and i paid to have one develloped according to my description.							
The way this works in joomla lms IMO is very intuitive.							
You make a question bank by adding question to the bank and assign the question to a category.							
When making a quiz							
you simply select the categories from whom to draw questions from and set how many questions to put into the quiz. This way when having a sound question base, you can make unique quizzes in a minute.							
Joomla LMS is a complex solution and overkill for many that is why I am here looking into to this quiz component, and of course ari quiz is much cheaper too.
