I am publishing the module in an article using the easy slider plugin. The show does pull up a static image - the last in my series. But no matter what I do I can't get the whole show to play from start to finish. Also, nothing works at all unless I turn Jquery off. I'm sure these are small issues. I've been using ARI products for a long time, and they are great.

Use "Auto-rotate reverse motion" parameter to specify direction in auto-rotate mode (from left-to-right or from right-to-left).

It doesn't make sense to load the same slider to the same slider (load "ARI Easy Slider" module with ID = 169, to "ARI Easy Slider" module with ID = 169) because it causes infinity loop and nothing will work.

If you want to use content plugins inside the slider, set "Articles -> Parse plugin tags" parameter to "Yes" in "ARI Easy Slider" module settings.
