  id = {$SESSION:article_id|empty:''}
```

If you want to use ID of currently opened article, try to use {\$REQUEST:id} variable in the query otherwise it is possible to create a custom Joomla! plugin which will set session variable(s).

SEF links are transformed to standard links by Joomla! before handling a request so {\$REQUEST:id} will contain ID of currently loaded article. Link to an article looks like `index.php?option=com_content&view=article&id=ARTICLEID`
