Hello.

Can you please point me to some documentation on how to use this plugin? I bought it to use it almost exclusively for MySQL, and I can't seem to get any heads or tails on how to use it. This is what I get as a graph: https://s11.postimg.org/cuh266tdb/Capture.jpg I used this query with another free plugin (plotalot) and it worked the way it was supposed to:

SELECT CONCAT(year(calendar.datefield),'-', LPAD(month(calendar.datefield), 2, '0')) AS ymonth, IFNULL(count(con inizio contratto),0) AS assunti, vear(calendar.datefield) AS anno.

month(calendar.datefield) AS mese,

IFNULL(count(con_licenziamento_data),0) AS licenziati FROM datipersonali RIGHT JOIN calendar ON (DATE(datipersonali.con_inizio_contratto) = calendar.datefield) WHERE (calendar.datefield BETWEEN (SELECT MIN(DATE(datipersonali.con_inizio_contratto)) FROM datipersonali) AND (SELECT MAX(DATE(datipersonali.con_inizio_contratto)) FROM datipersonali))

GROUP BY year(calendar.datefield), month(calendar.datefield), ymonth

Remove "anno" field from fields list in "SELECT" SQL query. You can use it is directly in "ORDER BY" clause if need this to sort data.

PS: When "Revert data" is set to "Yes", "Columns settings" parameters are applied to transformed table. It doesn't contain "anno" column, it contains "2011-06", "2011-07" and etc. columns.

As we wrote in our previous, the extension works with transformed table when "Revert data" is enabled. Alias can be set in SQL query. For example:

SELECT id AS `Product Id`, YEAR(C.created) AS `Created at`
