1. The module can be disabled, but don't uninstall it because it contains files which are used by the plugin.

2. Yes, it is possible. The extension can also generate thumbnails automatically. For this enter a path to big images in "Image path" parameter, set "Use thumbnails" parameter to "Yes" and specify "Thumbnail width" and/or "Thumbnail height" parameters. If you want to use your own thumbnails then enter path to thumbnails in "Thumbnails path" parameter. For example if big images are located in images/album folder and thumbnails are located in images/album/thumbs folder and have the same name as big images then set "Thumbnails path" parameter to thumbs/{\$fileName} value.

3. The slider looks fine for us when browser's window is resized. Could you provide an image where we can see the problem?
