| Specifying a width and height for all images allows for faster rendering by eliminating the need for unnecessary reflows and repaints. |

| Page Speed currently only detects image dimensions that are specified via the image attributes. If you are specifying the dimensions via CSS, then you can safely ignore this recommendation. Details from Google |
| When the browser lays out the page, it needs to be able to flow around replaceable elements such as images. It can begin to render a page even before images are downloaded, provided that it knows the dimensions to wrap non-replaceable elements around.
