This problem with site template or a plugin which is used to optimize loading of javascript and CSS files. It loads external javascript files incorrectly. You can disable load of jQuery library in "ARI Flip Book" module settings and add the next code to index.php file of site templates immediately after `<tag>`:

```
jQuery.noConflict();
```

you open HTML source of the page, you can see that all javascript files are combined into one file, it is not standard Joomla! behaviour and extension which do it, doesn't load external javascript files correctly.
