If you want to create a book based on images, it is enough to specify path to folder(s) where images are located. CSV file is used only if want to add some extra fields which will be shown in the book. CSV file can be easily extended (add new fields for example). Currently the extension provides ability to share publications in popular social networks. We are going to add ability to create bookmarks, share links for publication by email and etc.
