I've got the lightbox working great on desktop monitors where my images display at 1:1 pixel ratio.

However, on the iPad the images are enlarged to fill the screen. This can make the images look a little blurry on the sharp retina screen.

Is there a way to limit the maximum height and width of the images on the iPad (e.g. so they fill about 75% of the screen maximum)?

Hello,

Try the following solution: open "ARI Fancy Lightbox -> Settings -> Advanced" page and populate "Custom JS code" parameter with the following code:

```
$.fancybox.defaults.afterLoad = function(instance, current) {  
    if (current.type !== 'image') return ;  
  
    var pixelRatio = window.devicePixelRatio || 1;  
  
    if ( pixelRatio > 1.5 ) {  
        current.width = current.width / pixelRatio;  
        current.height = current.height / pixelRatio;  
    }  
}
```
