When an image opened in a lightbox, firefox scaled the image down to the same size as the thumbnail. If the image was then zoomed to original size with firefox, the lightbox would have scrollbars. I had already rewritten my code to create separate thumbnails as the images update, so i'm not too worried about having this functionality in the plugin. But thanks for adding the feature! _____ Re:Fancy Thumbnail - thumbnail cache time Posted by cplath - 2009/04/14 02:44 I seem to have a new problem since installing the new version, then uninstalling it and reinstalling the original 1.5.3 I downloaded.

I'm using FancyThumbnails within Accordion within Tabs. Now the thumbnails will not display properly in IE within the accordion if I've specified my own thumbnail using srcSmall. They do display correctly if I don't specify a thumbnail and allow the plugin to create the thumbnail.

The first two tabs are using auto-created thumbnails. The third tab is using the srcSmall parameter. They display correctly for me in FF3, but not in IE7. They displayed correctly in both IE7 and FF3 before trying to upgrade to the new version.

- 1) This works if I configure it on the plugin page, but not if I add the autoHeight="false" option to the tags (I'd prefer to leave this on by default and just turn it off for these problematic items)
- 2) This didn't resolve the problem. Additionally, it recreated the problem of the pop ups displaying with scrollbars
- 3) Same results as #2

Is is possible to go back to how it was before? I appreciate your responsiveness in adding features, but I'd rather not be a beta tester. I've put in quite a bit of time just to have more problems than originally.

At first, sorry for inconvenience. We don't wish to see you as beta-tester, but understand us, please. Before provide update we check it on our server, but environment on your server can be different and it can affected on the component work. Regarding to your previous post:

- 1) You have entered autoHeight parameter for incorrect element, specify it in {arijaccordion} tag instead of {arijaccordionitem} tag.
- 2) It seems that plugin can't set image size automatically because 'getimagesize' PHP function is failed. Specify width and heigh parameters for {arifancythumb} tag where it use with srcSmall parameters. It can look like:

{arifancythumb src="/images/forecasts/day1_psnow_gt_04.gif" srcSmall="/images/forecasts/thumbs/day1_psnow_gt_04.gif" width="500" height="375" title="Probability of Snow: 4in Tomorrow" group="day1"}

3) We have fixed issue with scrollbar, check your mail, please.
