It doesn't look like "ARI Smart Content" error. Probably you use JoomFish or similar extension? We suppose this error related to language extension.

While poking around with the Joomla 1.7.1=>1.7.2 upgrade, I found the following two SQL files

administrator/components/com_admin/sql/updates/mysql/1.7.0-2011-06-06.sql
administrator/components/com_admin/sql/updates/mysql/1.7.0-2011-06-06-2.sql

I manually ran the code which created the missing column and solved the aforementioned problem.

I am now getting a the following new error:

FROM jos_arisc_config

It seems "jos_arisc_config" table was dropped. Execute the next SQL query to restore the table:

We are getting closer.

I ran the SQL to create the table. Now when I enabled the Smart Content plug-in, the site no longer returns a blank screen. It looks like it works OK. However, the code in the articles does not get run. It just shows as the raw tags.

I tried to re-install Smart Content 1.8.1. The install message comes back as "Installing component was successful." but also includes this message:

Warning: Invalid argument supplied for foreach() in /ysi/www/html/libraries/joomla/database/database/mysqli.php on line 391

Is this an indication of more missing tables?

BTW, the Joomla version is 1.7.2. I also have ARI Data Tables installed.

I had 8 GB free in /tmp, so that was not the issue.

I added a `var_dump($table)` call just before line 391. It returned this:
`string(13) "#__arisc_file" string(16) "#__arisc_plugins"`

I checked the DB and found that there are no `jos_arisc_` tables other than the `jos_arisc_config` which I had manually created based on your prior response.

Should those tables be created with the plug-in is loaded? Could I just manually create the `arisc_file` and `arisc_plugins` tables? Are there other arisc tables?

Found the problem. I poked around in the install code and found the schema for the tables. I tried to manually create the tables which died on this:

```
CREATE TABLE IF NOT EXISTS `jos_arisc_plugin_params` (  
  `ParamId` int(11) unsigned NOT NULL,  
  `ParamValue` text NOT NULL default ""  
) ENGINE=MyISAM DEFAULT CHARSET=utf8;
```

MySQL 5.1.40 did not allow a default value to be set for text/blog fields. I remove the default setting, created all the tables, and reloaded the arismartcontent plug-in.

This allowed me to load 1.8.1 without error, but the plug-in seems to have no affect. The articles just display the ari tags as if the plug was not enabled. (I confirmed that the smart content plug-in and the extensions plug-in are enabled.)

I have the ARI Data Table product installed too. Could that be a problem?

I noticed that the jos_arisc_cofig, jos_arisc_css, and jos_arisc_plugin_params tables are empty. Is that expected?

These tables are empty on fresh installation. Check that "System - ARI Smart Content" plugin is enabled and if you use a WYSIWYG editor, switch it to plain text mode before inserting plugin code. WYSIWYG editors can add extra HTML code in design mode.
