Select "CSV files - CSV files" value in "Select source provider" drop-down in the appeared popup. After this click by "New source" button. Enter path to CSV file in "CSV File" parameter and click "Save & Close" button. Select the created data source (click by source's name) in source data grid. That's all.

File path is case-sensitive. For example if you want to show data from Report.csv file which is stored in /images/data filder then populate "CSV File" parameter with images/data/Report.csv value.
If it doesn't help, could you specify where you save the file and what value is used in "CSV File" parameter?
