When i changed the property settings of the css loader file in the folder from ARI YUI module the buttons yui menu changed from white boxed menu items into horizontal text(without visible button). This is the first thing i don't get because all the other menus display as boxes.

I've already played with firebug for hours but the only thing that changes when i copy the old menu code into the css box at the admin>module>CSSbox is the font.
