Hi Team,

I've made some changes to my safe\_menu.css http://www.coasttocountryweddings.com.au to get it just about right but would like to tweak it further. I cannot locate the place in the .css file where I need to make changes to affect:

Wedding Services menu;

1. There is what looks to be padding of about 20px from top, bottom & left edges to the text that I'd like to close up to about 5px maximum.

2. Presumably if 15px on the left was removed, then likewise the the pale yellow background (.yui-skin-sam UL Ll.yuimenuitem-selected) would also move left. Additionally, I'd like extend this pale yellow 'mouse-over' in length to the right edge of the menu/module. This would make it long enough to 'highlight' lengthy/wordier menu option links.

3. I would like to position the background image file menuitem\_submenuindicator.png further to the right, as some of my lengthy menu option links may/will over-run the indicator image.

Any help you can give is greatly appreciated.
