```
#header
{
  z-index: 2;
}
```

...which resolved my YUI menu issue, created a new problem.

My non YUI menu which originated with my template, now has a lower priority and that pull-down displays under the contents of other module content.

Is there a better CSS code that I can use on my YUI menu that does not impact my templates menu system?
