Use the following CSS rule:

.yuimenuitem-itemPARENT_ITEM_ID UL
{
 width: 150px !important;

Where PARENT_ITEM_ID is ID of parent menu item. For example if parent menu item Id is 207, use the following CSS rule:

.yuimenuitem-item207 UL { width: 150px !important; }
