The overlapping problem (i think it's a z-index issue but i'm not a coder and i'm a bit lost) happens only with IE6 and IE7. Firefox, Opera, Chrome and IE8 works well.

PS: By the way, i have been reading other post and i'm not very sure how i can modify the color for ari ext menu buttons and for the text inside when selected, when you have the mouse over it, and all that. In some post seems you have to make changes in the template.css of the template and in other post it seems you have to write it in the "CSS Style box" of the module properties. Add the following CSS rule:

```
DIV.art-content-layout DIV.art-sidebar1
{
  z-index: 100;
}
```

Custom CSS code can be placed into site template CSS file or to "CSS Styles" parameter, but if it contains predefined variables like { \$id }, it should be placed into "CSS Styles" parameter.
