I adjusted the padding for the top-row navigation (within menu.min.css under .ux-menu a) and it is displaying differently in different browsers/platforms. In IE 8, for example, the navigation overlaps and extends to a second row below. How can be adjusted it so it appears in line with the flash video below it and flush with the search bar to the right of it across all browsers?
