Open 'Extensions -> Module Manager' page on the component backend, choose 'ARI Ext Menu' in modules data grid and click 'Copy' button or if you want to create module instance from the scratch, click 'New' button and choose 'ARI Ext Menu' module.

```

and I got it. However, the problem is that it changed the size for both the horizontal menu on the top (topmenu) and the vertical menu on the left (mainmenu and keyconcept).

Any idea to specify that the size will be affected only for the specified menu either the top or the vertical.
