I finally got it. I had to set the z-index of .ux-menu li to a very large number. It seems that dj image slider must have a zindex set in the code that is very high since I couldn't find it in the css. I actually set z-indexing up to 100000 to get it to work properly in IE 6, although it worked fine in all of the other browsers before I made this change. Damn IE and it's strange behaviors.
