The module uses the following CSS files:

/modules/mod\_ariextmenu/mod\_ariextmenu/js/css/menu.min.css

/modules/mod\_ariextmenu/mod\_ariextmenu/js/css/menu.ie.min.css - contains some specific CSS rules for IE browsers.

These are minified versions of original CSS files. Original CSS files are located by the following path:

/modules/mod\_ariextmenu/mod\_ariextmenu/js/css/menu.css

/modules/mod\_ariextmenu/mod\_ariextmenu/js/css/menu.ie.css

You can edit this files and then rename it to menu.min.css and menu.ie.min.css
