level 2 = your SUB SUB MENU ITEM x

If you config: start = 1, end = 2 Joomla will render as follows: level 0 NO level 1 YES level 2 NO level 3 NO, etc
If you config: start = 1, end = 3 Joomla will render as follows: level 0 NO level 1 YES level 2 YES level 3 NO, etc
