Actually, a second problem appears when 'read more' is inserted, instead of the articles showing 1 by 1, 2 articles appear beneath each other which is a very ugly site.

I use the latest version Ari Slider (purchased 7-5-2011) and Joomla!1.6.3.

Does anybody no what is going wrong?
