The mask element has position "absolute" CSS property, try to use the next CSS rule that it will be positioned correctly:

DIV.ari_slider_item_inline { position: relative; }

We can recommend to use FireBug addon for FireFox browser that investigate page layout and elements styles. In your case this problem with custom styles.
