"File", "Title", "Link" "Packshot-Photography.jpg","Packshot","http://web-design-3d.co.uk/packshot-photography" "website-management.jpg","Packshot","http://web-design-3d.co.uk/packshot-photography"

CSV file should be located in folder with images.
