I'm wanting to use this to display inline html, but when tested I noticed that I don't have a lot of control over the background and border styles, as they are controlled dynamically by the plugin's parameters.

Ideally, rather than displaying a background color, I would like to display a background image (with inline html over the top), and I'd also like to modify the borders that contain the sexylightbox.

Now, I'm guessing I need to do a module override, But I can't seem to find the files that generate the following div classes:

SLB-Contenido
SLB-Top
SLB-Contenedor
SLB-Background
SLB-Wrapper

I need to go in to the code and delete the inline styles for these classes, so I can apply my own to a style sheet.
