Yes, it is possible to assign menu item(s) with sexy lightbox with help "System - ARI Sexy Links" plugin which is included into "ARI Sexy Lightbox" package. If you provide link to page with menu and say what menu item(s) do you want to link with sexy lightbox, we will help to configure the plugin or you can configure it by yourself, but it requires a little CSS knowledge.

If necessary to show lightbox if a user click by an image the following code can be used:

We have configured the plugin and now menu links are shown into the lightbox but it causes problem with "LOF Cordion" module. This module can't work if several jQuery instance are loaded. If add the following code into site template after tag and disable jQuery loading in other extensions like "LOF Cordion" and "ARI Sexy Lightbox" or contact "LOF" developers that they update their extension:

jQuery.noConflict();

It is not a problem with menu position, this is the problem with your menu module. It is not a problem to attach the lightbox menu item if a menu module uses normal HTML layout (for example tag with "href" which contains link), but your module doesn't contain link in HTML elements, it navigates to links with help javascript.
