Sorry to bother you again. I bought the software, but I am very new to Joomla and I've been struggling all day to set u the galleries as per the instructions I have found on your forum. There doesn't seem to be any other documentation to assist me so here I am.
I have installed arisexylightbox as per the readme instructions. I can get it to display a single popup from a pic as the documentation indicates using,

but setting up a gallery from a folder seems to be a whole different issue.

I followed these instructions I found in the forum:

It's easy. Choose 'Image gallery' in 'Choose type' drop-down, specify thumbnail size with help 'Thumbnail width' or 'Thumbnail height' parameters, type path to folder with images in 'Directories' textarea, assign module to necessary position and save the module. After this the module should display images from selected folder.

I have set the module to load with 'load module into article' into my photo article.
I understand that I am supposed to be able to put code directly into the article to load the component. (I think I am getting confused between the module and the component at times), but I don't know what the correct code is?
