What is the difference between sexylightbox and sexylightbox anywhere?

It seems both need to be configured, but neither seem to be able to do the following:

There will be several people accessing 'post' levels, the ability to post articles. It does not seem logical for them to have to learn how to cut & paste, and find IDs and such - code, in to their articles - since most will only have access to post articles, not the entire admin panel - just to add a lightbox link.

ARI email suggested I buy a few other things, and I did, but it does not explain how to add ARI to any template so that the person writes their article and saves it. ARI should auto-display the post with x number of teaser text, and a 'Show article' link to the proper full article into a lightbox.

I do not see much of a difference between either lightbox or lightbox anywhere except, one is a module the other system plugin.

As requested, I had sent a link to the pages, and was told that the link works. Yes, but each link in each article has to be hand cut & pasted. That is not what I was told one would have to do if I got lightbox stuff. I even switched to Ari slider in order to be more compatible.

As it stands, we are bust hand pasting and manually identifying which IDs to be used. A lot of work especially since article s will be up This is a teaser article with a lot of ipsum lorem More

It is real instructions how to configure the plugin and use it with other extensions. An image link usually looks like `image` and it works with solution which we described. BTW, it is possible to specify a CSS selector for necessary elements (for image, anchor and etc.). We describe a real working solution. If you can't configure the plugin, we can help to do it. Just provide a temporary access to your J! backend (if you don't want to provide access to real site, you can create a fresh test installation).
