The landing page of the site is a black screen with one large word which is a hyperlink. You click the word and a lightbox needs to open with the login form visible. Once logged in you leave the lightbox and access the site. If you are not registered you can't get past the landing page.

What I need seems simple enough but I have spent an entire day trying to resolve it.

Hello,

It is possible to show "ARI Sexy Lightbox" module only for guest users. For this you can use "Advanced Modules" extension. About limit access to the whole site for guest users, this is not work for lightbox extension. It is necessary to use an extension which limit access to specific part of sites or we can create a custom plugin which will redirect all non-registered users on frontend to specific page. If you are interested in this plugin, we can discuss details by email.
