Hi there

I've been using ARISexylightbox for three or four years on a client's site. Suddenly it is showing {\$EmptyText} instead of the Flickr images.

The resource use of the server has shot up. The error log generates the following: Notice: Undefined index: modal in .../plugins/system/arisexythumbnails/arisexythumbnails.php on line 83

I have downloaded the latest version but when I try and uninstall the earlier module i get the following error and the site crashes front and back end
