You can create new instance of 'ARI Sexy Lightbox' module and assign it with 'Homepage', after this set 'Open on load' to 'Only once' or 'Yes' value that open lightbox when homepage is loaded. After this create form in RSForm component, install 'RSForm! Content Plugin' that have possibility to load forms into an article, create new article and add the following code: {mosforme FORM ID} where FORM\_ID is ID of necessary form. Choose 'Remote content' type in 'ARI Sexy Lightbox' settings and enter the next value for 'URL' parameter: index.php?option=com\_content&view=article&tmpl=component&id=ARTICLE\_ID where ARTICLE ID is ID of article which were created before. After this the module with form should appear when homepage is loaded. PS: If you have any difficulties with it, you can provide temporary access to your Joomla! backend and we'll help to configure extensions.
